



# **EMBARKATION DAY - BOARDING PROCESS**

#### Cruise Terminal:

• Canada Place Cruise Ship Terminal – East Berth

### **Upon Arrival:**

- Terminal Arrival Time
  - Cruise Terminal Opens at 11 am
  - Select you Terminal Arrival Time during Online Check-In
  - In Hand: Passport, Xpress Pass, Medications, Personal Items
- Transfer of Luggage to Handlers:
  - Check your CEL Luggage Tags
  - Clear Luggage Tag Holders available on Amazon (will be shared in Get Ready #5 later this month)
  - Tipping
- Enter Terminal and Complete Registration
- Board Ship when called

### Boarding the Ship:

- Staterooms will be ready for occupancy
- Cruise Identification Cards (Room 'Key') will be in Mail Slot at your Stateroom
- Luggage will be in Stateroom on or before 6 pm
- Handouts at Boarding
  - Welcome Letter
  - Souvenir Program
  - Lanyards
- Cruise App



## **EMBARKATION DAY - ONCE ONBOARD**

#### Lunch:

- Ocean View Café (Deck 10) is open for lunch beginning at 11:30 am
- Aqua or Concierge: 11:30 am 1:30 pm (Cosmopolitan Restaurant, Deck 5)
- Suites: 11:30 am 1:30 pm (Luminae, Deck 4)

#### Excursions, Dining Reservations & Package Purchase:

- SCE Excursions and Land-Based Concerts Tickets/Confirmations will be delivered to your Stateroom on Embarkation Day; SCE will have a Shore Excursions Desk on Deck 3 for questions or booking additional available tours.
- If you were unable to complete your dining reservations and package purchases in advance, the time between boarding and the Sailaway Party is a great time to do so:
  - Spa Reservations: The Spa (Deck 10, Forward) or via phone
  - Specialty Dining: Stations set up in Grand Foyer (Deck 3) & Ocean View Café (Deck 10) or via phone
  - Beverage Packages: May be purchased at any bar/with any server (pre-cruise discounts will not apply)
  - WiFi Packages: Connect to "WiFi-Guest-Summit" and follow instructions to make purchase
  - Shore Excursions:
    - SCE Excursions: Wine Tours must be purchased by <u>July 31</u>; Available space on other tours may be purchased at the SCE Excursions Desk on Deck 3
    - Available tours from Celebrity Cruises may be purchased at the CEL Shore Excursions Desk (Deck 3)

#### Mandatory Safety Procedure:

- Watch the Safety Demonstration Video via Celebrity Cruise App or In-Room TV
- Proceed to your Muster Station (listed on your Cruise Identification Card or on the back of your stateroom door)
- Celebrity Cruises team member will verify and record your completion of the Safety Video & Check-In at station





- Tuesday, September 16
  - Brunch at Abaca Chef (& Owner): Francis Ang
    - Abaca is a contemporary Filipino-California restaurant, showcasing the beauty and vibrance of Filipino culture and cuisine from co-owners, Chef Francis Ang and his wife the Director of Operations Dian Ang. Abaca honors old family recipes and flavors while using some of Northern California's best seasonal ingredients. The cocktail program features a wide array of drinks from classics to imaginative Filipino-inspired libations. Abaca was named one of the Top 50 restaurants in America by the New York Times.
  - Lunch at Angler Chef de Cuisine: Joe Hou; owned by Saison Hospitality Group
    - Angler is a Michelin starred restaurant that opened on September 18th, 2018 as the second restaurant from Saison Hospitality and was named both GQ and Esquire's Best New Restaurant of the Year. Angler serves a seafood focused menu where every dish is touched by fire in some way and the exquisite dining room provides views of an expansive wood burning hearth and the San Francisco Bay.
  - Dinner at Boulevard Chef (& Owner): Nancy Oakes (James Beard Award for Best Chef: California in 2001)
    - Located in the historic Audiffred building, Boulevard is a celebrated San Francisco restaurant on the Embarcadero waterfront. First opened by Chef and Owner Nancy Oakes in 1993, Boulevard has continuously received high praise and a dedicated following from locals and tourists alike. Quintessentially Californian, the menu seamlessly incorporates the regional season bounty into its menu. In 2012 Boulevard received the James Beard Award for Outstanding Restaurant and their Wine List has received Wine Spectator's Best of Award each year since 1999. Guests will dine in a private room hosted by famed San Francisco Food Critic Michael Bauer.


### Wednesday, September 17

- Brunch at Parachute Chef (and owner): Alex Hong (Chef at Micheline Starred Restaurant, Sorrel)
  - Soon to be located in the San Francisco Ferry Building, Parachute is the newest Bakery location to soon hit the San Francisco food scene. Founded by Chef Alex Hong, Chef at the Michelin Starred Restaurant Sorrel, the bakery will debut in June and will feature treats in the Viennoiserie tradition. Chef Alex Hong and Michael Bauer will be working closely together to create a unique experience for our *Journey of Jazz* Guests.
- Lunch at Scoma Chef: Gordon Drysdale; Founded: 1965 by Al and Joe Scoma still family owned and operated; CEO: Tom Creedon (son-in-law to Al Scoma)
  - Founded in 1965 by brothers Al and Joe Scoma, this restaurant is a San Francisco staple, and a must for anyone interested in Fisherman's Wharf. Scoma's Pier to Plate Menu ensures the freshest seafood and continues to honor the restaurant's 60-year tradition. Michael Bauer has worked closely with Scoma's to ensure this is an exceptional experience. Guests will dine in the private Sports Room and will have access to Scoma's Private Pier where Fisherman daily drop of their catch to the restaurant. Chef Gordon Drysdale is creating a special menu that will highlight some of San Francisco's seafood delicacy.
- Lunch at Yank Sing Owners: Vera Chan Waller and Nathan Waller (Third Generation Owners/Operators)
  - Founded in 1958, this third-generation, family-owned Dim Sum restaurant is a renowned San Francisco go-to for locals and visitors like. Considered the go-to restaurant for San Francisco movers and shakers looking for Dim Sum, this is a restaurant all foodies must check off their list. The menu for the day will include some "off menu" items that are sure to be special. But don't worry, the famous soup dumplings and custard tarts will be plentiful. Winners of the James Beard Foundation America's Classic Award, along with the Michelin Guide Bib Gourmand, Yank Sing continues to be a San Francisco staple.





# **TAKEAWAYS**

- Make sure that your passport is valid...and that you know where it is!
- We highly recommend that guests arrive in Vancouver the day before embarkation to alleviate stress from any potential travel delays or issues. Vancouver is a larger metropolitan area than our standard embark cities, which may mean higher price points for accommodations, so securing a hotel reservation as soon as possible is strongly encouraged.
- Complete Online Check-In as soon as that service is activated.
- Complete as many purchases and reservations as you can BEFORE boarding the ship.
- Be alert to our announcement of the Performance Schedule. Pre-Planning your show schedule is important.
- Be sure to allow for extra time to reach the Cruise Terminal and arrive during selected time slot.
- Except for one night, the cruise is casual in terms of attire. Be comfortable and remember to bring layers for cooler evenings.
- Your choice of clothing should reflect the fact that irons and steamers are not allowed on the ship and dry cleaning is expensive and takes time.
- If you plan on dining with a particular group of guests, be sure to properly submit your Group Dining information.
- Try as hard as you can to leave your work, your obligations, and your worries at home.
- Be sure to pack your smile, your love of music, and, most of all, your humanity.


